



#### **Ingredients Needed:**

- 9 cups Corn Chex<sup>TM</sup> Rice Chex<sup>TM</sup> or Wheat Chex<sup>TM</sup> cereal
- 1 cup white chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup peanut butter
- 1/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 11/2 cups powdered sugar

#### Instructions

- 1. In large bowl, measure out cereal; set aside.
- 2. In 1-quart microwavable bowl, microwave white chocolate chips, peanut butter and butter uncovered on High 1 minute; stir. Microwave about 30 seconds longer or until mixture can be stirred smooth. Stir in vanilla. Pour mixture over cereal, stirring until evenly coated.
- 3. Add half of the powdered sugar into 2-gallon resalable foodstorage plastic bag, pour cereal mixture into bag and then add remaining powdered sugar. Seal bag; shake until well coated. Spread on waxed paper to cool. Add in candies and store in airtight container in refrigerator.

# A Spring Art Project



#### **Supplies:**

mixed media (or watercolor) paper pattern (optional)

Elmer's School Glue

paint

wooden skewer for mixing liquid watercolors

wooden scoop stick (or craft stick)

pipe cleaner

Elmer's Tacky Glue (or hot glue gun)

butterfly wings

black acrylic

pencil paint brush black poms googly eyes scissors

#### **Instructions:**

- l. Mix black paint in glue
- 2. Outline your butterfly with the black glue
- 3. After your black glue is dry, use your liquid watercolors to paint your butterfly wings.
- 4. Let your watercolor paint dry completely.
- To make your butterfly body, glue black poms onto a wooden scoop stick or craft stick.
- Then glue on pieces of a pipe cleaner behind your butterfly head for antennae, and two googly eyes.
- 7. Cut out butterfly.
