







Fun Halloween Family Craft

Materials:

Egg cartons Scissors Sharpie

Acrylic paint (orange, green, and white) Paint brush

Ribbon

Instructions to create:

Begin by cutting out the individual egg cups from the carton. Next you are going to paint the egg cups with two coats of acrylic paint. You need two egg cups for each project. Set aside to dry.

Once dry, use the Sharpie to draw on fun facial features to one egg cup (from each pair). The mouths happen quite naturally as egg cups tend to have lower points on the sides. Now fill the bottom of your treat box. Once you have filled the base, pop the head on, and tie a scrap of ribbon around him, knotting it at the top.



Halloween Banana Popsicle

Ingredients:

- 4 large fresh bananas (not overly ripe, or the bananas may be too soft)
- 1 cup nonfat Greek vanilla yogurt
- 2 tablespoons powdered sugar
- Mini semi-sweet chocolate chips (for eyes)
- 16 popsicle sticks



Directions:

Line Cookie sheet with parchment paper

Peel 2 bananas, cut in half and then cut them in half long ways Insert popsicle sticks into the ends of the pops

Freeze for 30 minutes to overnight

IN a small bowl, mix together frozen yogurt and powdered sugar Dip the banana into the mixture (yogurt and powdered sugar) Put chocolate chips in the top for eyes.
