







- Strawberries
- White candy melts (chocolate)
- Pink luster dust
- ToothPick
- Edible black write-on-gel
- Wax paper

you can start by melting your candy melts in a microwavable bowl at 30 second intervals stirring each time till melted. Once melted you dip the strawberries in the bowl and roll it around to cover most of it. Set on a piece of wax paper to cool. Once the chocolate hardens, grab your toothpick and some edible black gel to make the bunny's face. dip a tiny paintbrush in the pink luster dust and make the nose.
