Materials:

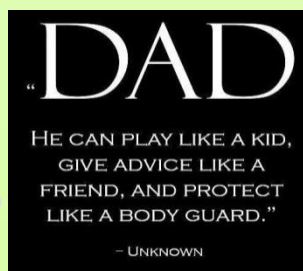
- Colored construction paper in letter size (8.5" x 11") Note, we found in this case, the thinner the paper the better, so cardstock is a bit harder to fold but thin construction paper works well.
- Materials to decorate outside of your card like pom poms, colored paper, confetti dots, and buttons.
- Adhesive like glue dots, double stick tape, glue
- Wallet size photo

Instructions:
