Ingredients

12 cups popped popcorn, 16 oz white candy coating such as Candiquik, 3 cups miniature pretzels, 10 oz M&M'S, 1/2 cup sprinkles and 10 oz miniature marshmallows

Instructions

- 1. Line a large baking sheet with parchment paper or a silicone mat.
- 2. Place popped popcorn on top of the parchment paper.
- 3. Melt candy coating according to package directions and pour over the top of the popcorn. Use tongs to toss to evenly coat popcorn
- Add the pretzels and M&M'S and toss with tongs to coat again.
- Add sprinkles and marshmallows and toss again.
- 6. Let the snack mix set for 30 minutes before breaking apart and serving.
- 7. Store leftovers in an airtight container.

Craft Stick and Buttons Snowflake Christmas Ornament

What you need:



- craft sticks
- buttons
- o glue kids can use low heat glue gun
- twine or string for hanging

Lay your sticks onto a flat surface making a star shape. Glue them together with hot glue. Apply buttons onto your sticks. We started with a large one in the center and worked outwards from there. Use the low temperature glue gun to glue the buttons to the sticks. Alternatively you can also use white school glue (works OK, but patience is required) or glue dots. Cut a piece of twine or string and hot glue it to the back of your stick to hang. All done!
