LEAF SCIENCE EXPERIMENT:

MATERIALS:

- Mason Jars (3-4)
- Large Coffee Filters
- Leaves
- Rubbing Alcohol

WHY DO LEAVES
CHANGE COLORS

PROCEDURE:

Gather fall-colored leaves (at least 3-4 different colors). Grind up/tear each color leaves into small pieces. Place leaves in each mason jar and cover with rubbing alcohol. Make a cone shape with each coffee filter and place the pointed tip in each mason jar. Watch as the coffee filter absorbs the color from the leaves.
