



FALL PUMPKIN PUDDING PLAY DOUGH

Ingredients

1/4 cup pumpkin spice flavored instant pudding mix

(note: If you use a 3.4 oz. box, you will enough left-over for second batch)

1 cup corn starch

⅓ cup warm water

Supplies

Mixing Bowl

Mixing spoon

Plastic mat

Themed Toys and Items - We did a fall theme with trees and colorful leaves, but you can do any theme you wish.

Instructions

Start by measuring and adding the pudding mix to the mixing bowl. TEACHING TIP! This making this pudding playdough is a great time to talk about fractions.

Now add half of the corn starch to the bowl. Have your kids work out that half equals 1/2 cup in this recipe. Pour in the water. Mix the dough well. You can start with a spoon but will need to start working it with your hands once it starts to pull together.

Add in the other half of the corn starch. Continue mixing it all together. Finish by kneading the dough with your hands until you get the desired consistency. The dough should feel soft to the touch and should not be sticky once it is ready.

If your dough continues to be sticky even after lots of kneading, add a bit more corn starch. Place the dough on a plastic mat for play time! Add in your themed items and start playing and exploring. *Taste Safe!*
