



## Craft Stick Flowerpots

### Materials Needed:

- Colored craft sticks
- Rubber bands
- Clean tin cans
- Ribbon
- Soil & flowers



### Instructions:

- Take a rubber band and place it around the tin can, making sure it's a snug fit.
- Take a craft stick and place it underneath the rubber band. Continue doing this all the way around the can until it is filled.
- To cover the rubber band, wrap a piece of ribbon around the can and cut it a few inches longer. Pull it tight around the can and tie in a bow or knot, trim off any extra ribbon.
- Fill the can with some soil and plant a flower to finish up this craft stick flower pot project!
- Since you don't have drainage holes in the bottom of the can, make sure not to overwater the flowers. OR you can definitely poke some holes in the bottom before starting the project.
