Materials

- 1/2 CUP CLEAR ELMER'S GLUE
- 1/2 CUP WATER
- 1 TEASPOON BAKING SODA
- 1.5-2.5 TABLESPOONS CONTACT LENS SOLUTION
- PINK AND RED FOOD COLORING
- UNCOOKED BLACK BEANS OR OTHER BLACK BALLS FOR SEEDS



INSTRUCTIONS

THIS RED SLIME WITH SEEDS LOOKS JUST LIKE THE INSIDE OF A JUICY WATERMELON FRUIT. PLUS THIS WATERMELON SLIME RECIPE HAS THE BEST TEXTURE THAT SHEETS BEAUTIFULLY, IS NOT TOO STICKY, AND IS QUICK AND EASY TO MAKE.

STEP 1: MIX TOGETHER THE WATER, GLUE, AND. FOOD COLORING UNTIL YOU GET THE COLOR YOU'D LIKE.

STEP 2: ADD THE CONTACT SOLUTION AND BAKING SODA.

STEP 3: ADD THE BLACK BEANS TO LOOK LIKE WATERMELON SEEDS AND MIX TOGETHER WITH YOUR HANDS.
