Frozen Banana Penguins

SUPPLIES

- 1 cup Chocolate Chips
- One bag Reese's Pieces
(Can also use M & M's)
- A bushel of bananas
- Freezer
- Microwave
- Parchment paper (or wax paper)



INSTRUCTIONS

STEP 1: PUT CHOCOLATE CHIPS IN MICROWAVE-SAFE BOWL

Stir the chips after 30 seconds and microwave for another 30 seconds.

STEP 2: CUT BANANAS IN HALF.

Cut the bananas so they have a flat bottom and carefully dip in chocolate until the top and sides have been covered.

STEP 3: ADD YOUR EYES, FEET AND BEAK

Attach Reeces pieces as eyes to the still melty chocolate and half of the orange ones as a beak. I also attached two orange ones as feet

STEP 4: FREEZE

Then put the penguins in the freezer for about 20 minutes. I sprayed tin foil with pan spray to make sure they came off easily.
